**Bible Story:** Birth of Jesus (Luke 2:1-21; Matthew 2:1-12)

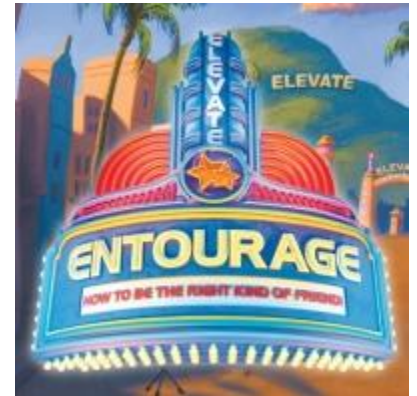
